Tuesday, April 13, 6 p.m.

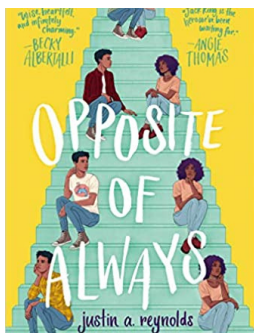
